

# Auto Body Repair Cost Ranges

Typical US repair cost ranges by damage type, so you can sanity-check an estimate. These are ranges, not quotes.

## Typical ranges

Real numbers depend on your car, the damage, parts, and your area. Use these only to understand the ballpark.

Damage type	Typical range
Minor dent / paintless dent repair	\$75 - \$400
Bumper repair / refinish	\$300 - \$900
Bumper replacement	\$550 - \$1,800
Single-panel repaint	\$400 - \$1,200
Door panel repair & paint	\$500 - \$2,500
Windshield replacement + recalibration	\$300 - \$1,500
Frame / structural repair	\$1,500 - \$10,000+
Hail damage (whole vehicle)	\$1,000 - \$5,000+

## What moves the price

Hidden structural damage found after teardown (paid via a supplement to your claim).

OEM vs aftermarket vs used parts.

Whether your car needs ADAS camera and sensor recalibration.

Paint type and how many panels need blending.
